An Enrollment Contract with The University School for education services to be provided to a District resident student under the student's IEP, beginning March 13, 2018 and ending on June 6, 2018.

A contract with OA Systems, LLC for managed internal broadband services for the 2018-2019 school year and renewable for one additional year.

A Commercial Service Agreement with Armstrong Utilities, Inc., for dark fiber strand delivered to three sites, for a five-year term beginning on the date service is first made available.

A Commercial Service Agreement with Armstrong Utilities, Inc., for 50M Metro Ethernet service, for a five-year term beginning on the date service is first made available.

An Affiliation Agreement with Clarion University of Pennsylvania, for the placement of student teachers as part of the University's education program, during the 2018-2019 through 2021-2022 school years.

The acceptance of 2017-2018 classroom grants from the Freeport Area School District Foundation, in the total amount of \$2,345.

Acceptance of an Innovative Classroom Grant (2018) Award from the PPG Foundation, in the amount of \$1,000, to be used to cover expenses related to the Science Program at the Freeport Area Middle School.

Acceptance of a Grant Award from the PPG Foundation, in the amount of \$900, to be used to cover transportation expenses for Middle School Science Department field trips.

Acceptance of Grant Awards from Audubon Society Education and donorschoose.com, each in the approximate amount of \$500, to be used to cover expenses related to the Science Program at the Freeport Area Middle School.

Agreements for pupil transportation services with W. L. Roenigk, Inc., and Valley Lines, Inc., for a nine-year term, effective with the 2018-2019 school year and ending with the 2026-2027 school year.

A contract with Roger V. Kaufman, to serve as a substitute School Police Officer, contingent on satisfactory completion of all pre-appointment requirements.
